

COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR JUDGES CUP 2020

Thanks to everyone for attending JUDGES CUP . The GA -NAWWJ & along with Ultimate Gymnastics have come up with safety guidelines to keep all of our spectators and gymnasts as safe as possible. We ask that all gymnasts and spectators adhere to these guidelines to allow everyone to have a safe experience.

- Each gymnast will only be allowed two spectators. Adults preferred.
- Please do not attend if you are feeling ill or have been around other feeling ill.
- All spectators, gymnasts, coaches, and judges must wear a mask upon entry to the building. ALL SPECTATORS AND COACHES MUST WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES IN THE VENUE.
- Gymnasts will also be required to wear a mask during down times as well as at awards. They will not be required to wear it at stretch, warm up or competition.
- Gymnasts need to bring their own water bottles and chalk in their own personal bins.
- Make sure your gymnast arrives dressed and ready for competition. The bathrooms will not be open to do hair and change clothes.
- PLEASE ARRIVE 15 MIN PRIOR TO STRETCH, DO NOT ARRIVE EARLIER THAN THAT. The building must be cleared and disinfected between sessions.
- The seating will be marked, and team spectators will sit in their assigned area with their team. Those areas will also allow for social distancing. You will be allowed to move and take a photo of your child, but we ask you to be respectful to others and try to maintain social distance.
- Awards will be done on the floor with the girls staying with their teams. We will call names and girls will stand. A volunteer will bring their medal to them.
- AT THE END OF AWARDS, WE ASK THAT THE SPECTATORS REMAIN SEATED. WE WILL CALL YOUR GYM'S NAME. AT THAT TIME, YOU MAY PICK YOUR CHILD UP FROM AWARDS AND EXIT ACCORDINGLY.
